RE: Notification - Retirees Can Go Back To Work!

Dear Retiree,

The Trustees of the IBEW Local 86 Pension Fund have approved retirees going back to work and will amend the Plan as follows.

DRAFT OF WORDING:

If a Participant becomes employed in Post-Retirement Employment **within the Local 86 jurisdiction** between **June 26, 2017 and August 27, 2017**, such Participant's monthly benefit payment shall not be permanently withheld during any months or payroll periods of Post-Retirement Employment occurring from the date of such employment through **August 27, 2017**. However, if a Participant becomes employed in Post-Retirement Employment for any reason after such date, his monthly benefit payment shall be permanently withheld during each month or payroll period of Post-Retirement Employment occurring thereafter.

In short you are allowed to work over 40 hours in one month and still receive your Local 86 Pension for the period between **June 26, 2017 and August 27, 2017**. To qualify you must...

- 1- Signed your pension paperwork by **June 26, 2017 and have it approved by the Trustee by that date.**
- 2- Sign the book and have a paid dues receipt.
- 3- **The work MUST be in the Local 86 jurisdiction!** Working in another Union's jurisdiction in New York State does not qualify.
- 4- Come into the Union Office to sign a letter to stop your NEBF and/or IO Pension if receiving them.
