Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I hope this letter finds you and your family safe and healthy. I would like to inform you, the vote to disburse the \$2.75 raise will be conducted, as **Notified**, on **Friday, April 5, 2024**. Voting will be from 11:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. at the Local 86 Union Hall. **A current dues receipt and photo I.D. are required to cast your vote.** With the work projection for 2024 shaping up to be as good if not better than last year; it is my personal feeling that a \$2.75 increase to the paycheck is extremely important:

one to help entice people to help us work the calls (be that through new membership or travelers coming to town) and the second being the most obvious, to help curb the ever-increasing cost of goods and services.

Furthermore, the Trustees have been advised by the actuaries that a minimum allocation to the Pension in the amount of .25 cents and .15 cents to the Health & Welfare are required to maintain their growth and sustainability.

There will be three options on the ballot for wage disbursement:

\$0.10 Supplemental
\$0.30 Pension
\$0.20 Annuity
\$2.00 Check
- CHOICE #2:** \$0.15 Health & Welfare
\$0.00 Supplemental
\$0.25 Pension
\$0.15 Annuity
\$2.20 Check
- CHOICE #3:** \$0.15 Health & Welfare
\$0.00 Supplemental
\$0.35 Pension
\$0.25 Annuity
\$2.00 Check
